Trees and Trails Program for 2021

Trees – There are no major projects in regards to planting, spraying or treating trees in 2021, as this was addressed in 2020.

Chipping – The dates have not been set as of this time, but we expect that Summit County will continue this program in 2021. As a reminder, your slash/chipping piles may only be placed on the street **2 weeks prior** to the week of your scheduled pick-up. Also, please refer to the Summit County website for information on the type of slash that is allowed. We had several owners this past year that did not get their piles picked up because the material was not suitable for chipping.

Trails – We did not host a work day in 2020. Pending COVID restrictions, we will resume our annual workday program in 2021. This is a volunteer activity and it can be strenuous, but we will provide lunch. More information to follow in the spring. When hiking please notify us with trail concerns. Wildfire Preparedness – We made a concentrated effort in 2020 to reduce our risk to wildfires. The Board removed standing, dead timber on common HOA property and worked with home owners to address individual trees on private land. The slash piles from our 2019 program north of Black Hawk Circle were removed and we addressed the large collection of standing and downed, dead timber on the HOA trail above Two Cabins Drive (over ~100 dead trees removed). Hydro seeding and planting of wildflower seeds were used to revegetate the impacted areas from the Two Cabins work. The Town of Silverthorne continues to emphasize dead tree removal, so please contact the Board if you identify any trees that are dead, whether standing or fallen. We will continue addressing areas of concern in our community in 2021.
